The Physiological Approach to the Treatment of Obstructive Sleep Apnea.

Obstructive sleep apnea (OSA) is an integral part of cranio-mandibular dysfunction.

Studies show that 75% of patients with TMD have OSA. Therefore, it is not possible to successfully treat patients with TMD without taking into account the manifestations of OSA.

The success of any dental treatment, from the correction of malocclusion, the aesthetic reconstruction of dentition, to the treatment of TMD depends on the ability of the doctor to properly screen patients to timely identify, prevent and treat OSA.

The presentation will reveal the basic principles of screening, prevention and treatment of OSA for children and adults.
